### 1. Possible secondary schools

### Hauptschule (Secondary school up to the 10<sup>th</sup> grade) (HS West, Stubbenweg)

- basic general education
- professional orientation
- qualifications: special school qualification with a focus on learning or secondary school qualification after the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or secondary qualification after the 10<sup>th</sup> grade (also extended SEK I)

# Realschule (Secondary school up to the 10<sup>th</sup> grade) (RS Delmenhorst, Holbeinstraße and Lilienstraße)

- extended general education
- professional or study-related educational path
- <u>qualifications</u>: special school qualification with a focus on learning or secondary school qualification after the 10<sup>th</sup> grade secondary qualification after the 10<sup>th</sup> grade (also extended SEK I)

# Oberschule (OBS Süd, Brendelweg and Wilhelm-von-der-Heyde-OBS, Uhlandstraße)

- both basic and advanced general education
- professional orientation
- from the 8<sup>th</sup> grade onwards, school type-related teaching (HS and RS)
- qualifications: special school qualification with a focus on learning or secondary school qualification after the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or secondary qualification after the 10<sup>th</sup> grade (also extended SEK I)

#### Gymnasium (GY on Willmsstraße and Max-Planck-GY, Max-Planck-Straße)

- broad and in-depth general education
- enables you to continue your education at a college, university or a career-related path
- <u>qualifications</u>: secondary qualification after the 10<sup>th</sup> grade (also extended SEK I) or school part of the technical college entrance qualification after the 11<sup>th</sup> grade at the earliest or *Abitur* after the 13<sup>th</sup> grade

## Integrierte Gesamtschule (Comprehensive school) (IGS Delmenhorst, Pestalozziweg)

- both basic and extended and in-depth general education
- learning development reports up to the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, followed by grades
- qualifications: special school qualification with a focus on learning or secondary school qualification after the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or secondary qualification after the 10<sup>th</sup> grade (also extended SEK I) or school part of the technical college entrance qualification after the 11<sup>th</sup> grade at the earliest or *Abitur* after the 13<sup>th</sup> grade

### 2. Decision making

#### Learning development

- Thinking
  - comprehension
  - retention/memory
  - dealing with facts
  - recognize and transfer connections
  - creativity in the learning process
- Language
  - expressiveness
  - mastering technical terms
  - spelling and Grammar
- Motivation / Interest / Expertise
- Concentration
- Endurance / resilience / dealing with setbacks

### 3. Registration

- carried out by legal guardians
- copy of certificate (4th school year, 1st half year) IGS (the last 3 certificates)
- copy of the report if there is a special educational need
- copy of birth certificate
- if necessary, official confirmation of custody
- if necessary, a copy of state benefit notifications

Most important principle: parental choice

Parents decide which type of school their child will attend after the 4<sup>th</sup> grade.
